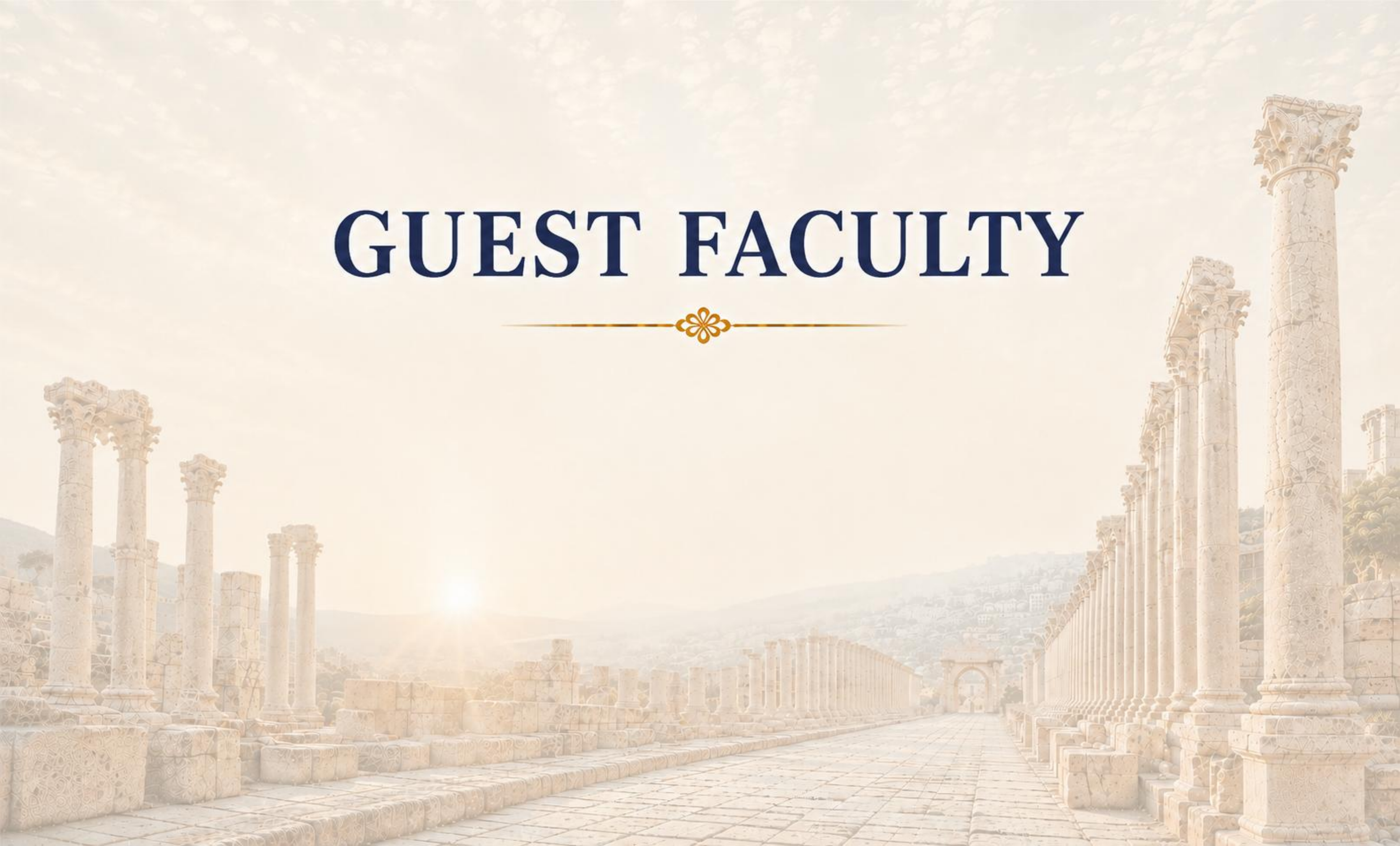

Dr. Ahmad Sayasneh, UK

Dr Ahmad Sayasneh is a Consultant Gynaecological Oncologist at Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust in London and an Assistant Professor in Women's Health at King's College London. He is internationally recognised for his expertise in ovarian cancer surgery, advanced robotic gynaecological oncology, and the use of imaging and artificial intelligence in cancer care. He has extensive experience in complex robotic, laparoscopic, and open surgery, including advanced ovarian cancer cytoreduction and radical pelvic procedures. His research focuses on ovarian cancer diagnosis, predictive ultrasound and AI, surgical outcomes, and robotic surgery, with numerous peer-reviewed publications and international collaborations. He is also actively involved in medical education, mentoring, research, and international surgical training, and is committed to advancing the standards of gynaecological cancer care through clinical excellence, innovation, and research.



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Dr. Alessandro Dafiero, Italy

Alessandro D'Afiero, MD, MSc, is an internationally recognized Italian urogynecologist and pelvic reconstructive surgeon with over 40 years of clinical, surgical, academic, and leadership experience. He specializes in urogynecology, female pelvic floor reconstruction, minimally invasive gynecologic surgery, and complex pelvic floor disorders.

He has held senior leadership positions within the Italian National Health Service, including Director of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Urogynecology Units. He has authored over 40 scientific publications and has been an invited speaker and live surgeon at international conferences across Europe, the Middle East, and Asia.

Dr. D'Afiero is recognized for developing innovative collagenogenesis-based techniques for pelvic organ prolapse surgery. He currently serves as Director of the Women's Department at Santa Maria Hospital – GVM Care & Research, Bari, Italy.



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Prof. Alexander Popov, Russia

Dr. Med. Prof. Aleksander Popov is Head of the Gynecology and Robotic Surgery Department at the Moscow Regional Scientific Research Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology. He is Vice President of the Russian Association of Human Reproduction (RAHR) and a member of RAEG, RAE, AAGL, ESGE, EEL, WES, SERGS, and SEUD. He is also the elected President of the Asian Society of Endometriosis and Adenomyosis (ASEA).

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Miss. Alison Wright, UK

Dr Alison Wright is a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist based in London and the current President of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG), having taken up the three-year post in December 2025 after being elected in June 2025 as the College's 33rd President. Clinically, she works in the NHS at the Royal Free London hospital in Hampstead and privately at the Portland Hospital, where she serves as lead Consultant for Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Vice-Chair of the Medical Advisory Committee. Her clinical interests include high-risk pregnancies, childbirth trauma, urogynaecology, pelvic floor dysfunction and menopause.

Prof. Amr ElNoury, UK

Professor Amr ElNoury, FRCOG (London), FRCS (Edinburgh), MD

Professor Amr ElNoury is a distinguished Egyptian obstetrician and gynecologist whose career spans more than four decades of clinical excellence, surgical innovation, academic leadership, and national health advocacy. He is the newly elected President of the Federation of Arab National Societies of Gynecology & Obstetrics (FAGOS) and a Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Cairo University, where he has shaped generations of clinicians and contributed to major national and regional health strategies.



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Prof Andrew Shennan, UK

Tommy's Chair of Maternal and Fetal Health at King's College London, King's College lead for Tommy's National Centre for Preterm Birth Research.

Professor Andrew Shennan is Professor of Obstetrics at King's College London, where he is Tommy's Chair of Maternal and Fetal Health and King's College lead for Tommy's National Centre for Preterm Birth Research. He also leads the Preterm Birth Surveillance Clinic at Guy's and St Thomas' Hospital. He is Chair of the Board of Trustees of the UK charity Action on Pre-eclampsia.

He specialises in clinical trials in antenatal and intrapartum care. He led the MAVRIC trial, which showed that an abdominal stitch can save babies' lives by reducing preterm birth for high-risk women who have had a previous failed vaginal stitch. He also developed the QUIPP app to help doctors predict an individual's risk of premature birth. His research interests include interventions to predict and prevent preterm birth, pre-eclampsia, and reduce global maternal and perinatal mortality. He has published over 500 peer-reviewed research reports. You can view Professor Shennan's research portfolio on ORCID.

He was awarded the international 2017 Newton Prize for excellence in research and innovation in support of economic development and social welfare in low and middle-income countries. In 2018, he was made an OBE (Officer of the Order of the British Empire) for his services to maternity care.



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Dr. Argyro Syngelaki , UK

Dr Argyro Syngelaki is a Reader in Maternal-Fetal Medicine at King's College London and a Specialist Consultant Midwife in Fetal Medicine at the Harris Birthright Research Centre for Fetal Medicine at King's College Hospital, London UK. Argyro is also the Research and Innovation Lead for Fetal Medicine and Women's Health at King's College Hospital and an Expert member of the UK National Research Ethics Committee serving on the London-Dulwich Committee.

She gained her BSc in Midwifery from the Technological Educational Institute of Athens, Greece in 2006. In 2008, Argyro joined the team of Professor Nicolaides at King's College Hospital and completed her fellowship in Fetal Medicine with a grant from the Fetal Medicine Foundation. Whilst working in Fetal Medicine and doing research at Kings, Argyro obtained two PhD degrees; one on Diabetes and Obesity in pregnancy from Utrecht University, The Netherlands and one on Screening for pregnancy complications at 11-13 weeks' gestation from Manchester Metropolitan University, UK.

Argyro's career has been devoted to maternal and fetal medicine research with the mentorship and support of Professor Kypros Nicolaides. Her interests include prediction and prevention of adverse pregnancy outcomes including preeclampsia, stillbirth and gestational diabetes mellitus and screening for fetal defects. She has published more than 220 peer reviewed papers in prestigious international journals, including the New England Journal of Medicine.



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Prof. Ariana Jawad , Kurdistan

Prof. Dr. Ariana Khalis Jawad Al-Barzanji is a Professor and Senior Consultant in Obstetrics and Gynecology, holding Fellowships of the Iraqi Board (FICOG) and Arab Board (CABOG). She is the President of the Kurdistan Higher Council of Medical Specialties (KHCMS) and previously served as Manager of the Maternity Teaching Hospital in Erbil, Head of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Hawler Medical University, and Program Director at KHCMS.

She is the Founder and President of KISOG and a Board Member of the Middle East Fertility Society (MEFS), with memberships in ASRM, ACOG, ASOG, and RCOG. She is also an International Examiner for the Jordanian Medical Council and Arab Board, contributing to medical education and examination standards.

Her clinical and research interests include high-risk obstetrics, maternal mortality, infertility and reproductive medicine, cervical screening and HPV, endometrial pathology, ovarian tumours, and gynecologic surgery. She is Patron of the Advanced Medical Journal, a former member of the Kurdistan National Assembly, and completed executive education at the Harvard Kennedy School.



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Dr. Asma Khalil , SA

Dr Asma Khalil, FRCOG is a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist at King Abdulaziz Medical City, Jeddah, and Assistant Professor at King Saud bin Abdulaziz University for Health Sciences. Trained in the UK, she is a Fellow of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists with extensive experience in obstetrics, minimally invasive gynaecological surgery, early pregnancy care, and medical education. An active researcher and international speaker, she has published widely in women's health and currently serves as the RCOG International Representative Committee Chair for Saudi Arabia, promoting education, collaboration, and excellence in women's healthcare.



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Prof. Attilio Di Spiezio Sardo , Italy

Dr Attilio Di Spiezio Sardo obtained his Medical Degree in 2000, Certification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology in 2005 and PhD in Human Development, Reproduction and Growth in 2008. He has been member of the Teaching Faculty at Unit of Minimally Invasive Therapy & Endoscopy Training Centre while at the Royal Free Hospital, London in 2003. Winner in 2008 and 2015 of the Golden Hysteroscope Award for the best scientific paper submitted at the Annual Congress of American Association of Gynecological Endoscopy (AAGL) Actually he is Full Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Chief of the Hysteroscopy Unit at the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, University of Naples "Federico II", Italy. Author of more than 170 articles published in international peer-review journals, 1 book on hysteroscopy (translated in English and chinese), 15 book chapters and 1 educational DVD He has been personally invited as speakers in more than 200 national and international meetings and he has actively organized 30 national and international courses and scientific meetings. He is actually member of the Executive Board of the European Society of Gynecological Endoscopy (ESGE) and has contributed to the development of the Gynaecological Endoscopic Surgical Education and Assessment (GESEA) programme within the ESGE.



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Dr. Birgit Arabin, Germany

Dr. Birgit Arabin is a Consultant in Obstetrics & Gynecology and a specialist in Maternal-Fetal Medicine and Prenatal Medicine from Germany. She is a Visiting Professor at Charité-Humboldt University, Berlin, since 2019, and a Senior Consultant in Maternal-Fetal Medicine and High-Risk Pregnancy. She has extensive experience in Perinatal Medicine, with research interests including prevention of preterm birth, fetal growth, prenatal diagnosis, twin pregnancy, and fetal programming. She has published more than 150 peer-reviewed papers and approximately 50 books and book chapters, and has delivered over 500 international lectures in the field of Perinatal Medicine.



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Prof. Christoph Lees, UK

Christoph is Professor of Obstetrics at Imperial College London; Honorary Consultant in Obstetrics and Head of Specialty for Fetal Medicine at the Centre for Fetal Care, Queen Charlotte's and Chelsea Hospital, Divisional Director for Womens, Cardiac and Support Services, Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust and Clinical Director for Fetal Medicine for North West London. He has developed the concept of multidisciplinary 'one stop' fetal neurology cardiology, urology/nephrology, genetics, placenta accreta/vas praevia, multiple pregnancy and facial morphology clinics at the Centre for Fetal Care which involves 2D, 3D and Doppler imaging and specialists in these disciplines. Christoph's main research interests are in fetal growth restriction as founder and Chief Investigator of the TRUFFLE group, imaging for Placenta Accreta Spectrum, intrapartum ultrasound, ultrasound simulation training, maternal cardiovascular function/pre-eclampsia and non invasive fetal surgery using high intensity focussed ultrasound (HIFU). Outside Imperial he is Visiting Professor at KU Leuven (Belgium) and the Medical University of Vienna. Since 2024 he has been an Associate Editor of the American Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology.



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Dr. Diana Mihai, Romania

Dr. Diana Mihai, MD, PhD, is a Consultant in Obstetrics and Gynecology, President of the Romanian Society of Aesthetic Gynecology (SREG), and Founder of Ladies Excellence Clinic, Bucharest.

Passionate about improving women's quality of life, she focuses on regenerative gynecology, using PRP and other injectables, CO₂ laser, radiofrequency, and pelvic floor therapies. With a PhD in infertility and extensive experience in IVF, urogynecology and minimally invasive procedures, her work blends science with empathy and real patient needs.



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Dr. Elena Greco, UK

Dr Elena Greco is a Senior Clinical Academic at Queen Mary University of London (QMUL) and a Consultant Obstetrician with a sub-specialty in Maternal and Fetal Medicine at The Royal London Hospital, Barts Health NHS Trust.

Her research interests include the prediction and prevention of pregnancy complications, intrapartum care, and communication in fetal medicine. She is the Chief Investigator of two UK multicentre randomised controlled trials: one evaluating less stringent diagnostic thresholds for gestational diabetes in twin pregnancies, and the other investigating the safety, efficacy and cost-effectiveness of the novel OdonAssist instrument for assisted vaginal birth compared with ventouse

Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of Alexandria, Egypt, and Clinical and Scientific Director of Alexandria Fertility and IVF Center. He has served on the Editorial Boards of Human Reproduction, Zygote, and RBM Online, and reviewed for 15+ journals.
